Thorough pre-flight equipment check
Thorough passenger briefing
Thorough pre-takeoff check with accepted clip-in procedure
At least two take-offs
At least two landings within a 30m diameter circle, pilot and passenger must land in the standing position
Demonstrate height loss techniques as they relate to tandem paragliders, i.e. wing-overs, big ears, two 360 deg turns within 20 seconds
<p>NOTE: In accordance with OPM Section 4 Operations - SAFETY OF HANG GLIDERS AND PARAGLIDERS commercial tandem paraglider flights must use a documented NZHGPA accepted procedure or system over and above the standard pre-flight check to ensure "clip-in".</p>

a) Have a total airtime of 100hrs and 500 flights.
b) Hold minimum of PG3 Certificate with 50 hours airtime since gaining PG3 Certificate
c) Hold a Paraglider Passenger 1 Certificate (PP1)
d) 30 Logged tandem flights as pilot in command.
e) Attended a tandem seminar within the last 24 months.
